CANADIAN JOURNALIST CATCHES IMMIGRANT ADVOCATE BREAKING LAW

Caught on Camera: 'Lie for Asylum'

• American head of NGO immigrant group caught teaching migrants how to cry, feign illness, pretend to be Christians—anything to fool border guards

he director of a major non-governmental organization (NGO) in Europe that provides legal aid to migrants and helps facilitate the overall asylumseeking process has been caught on tape admitting to coaching their clients to deceive and lie to border police in order to successfully gain political asylum, it has been revealed. Immigration critics are now wondering just how widespread this is and if NGOs in the U.S. and in Central America are doing the very same thing.

Lauren Southern, a popular Canadian independent journalist, political pundit, and documentary filmmaker, released the shocking video earlier this week, sparking outrage and condemnation around the world.

Europe and the wider Western world, particularly countries bordering the Mediterranean Sea, such as Greece and Italy, have seen a

Media, Banks, Silicon Valley Coddle Radical Left

hen does the left go too far? That's an important question to ponder today, because we certainly know where the mainstream media, the banks, academia, and Silicon Valley stand when it comes to conservatives. It's obvious that, for them, if you're even just a smidge to the right of the neoconservatives, then it's perfectly acceptable to censor, pillory, and blackball you. But, when it comes to the left, for the media elites, the big banks, and the tech companies, the answer is pretty much never. You can get away with lying, abusive language, bullying, threats, intimidation, even violence—and you'll still be allowed to go about your day-to-day business for the most part unchecked.

Take a look at the article by John Friend in this week's edition on page 26. In his report, John details how extremist leftist groups have been openly targeting and threatening conservative figures, including politicians and private citizens.

In one of the more despicable cases cited by John, Fox News host Tucker Carlson's family has been targeted multiple times over the course of the past few months. In one incident, Carlson's 19-year-old daughter was accosted in a country club restaurant by an older, bigger man, who shouted despicable things at her. Ironically, the man, Juan Granados, sits on the board of an advocacy group that supposedly empowers women, but when a female reporter from a Washington-based news and commentary website that is affiliated with Carlson reached out to the group on three occasions, guess what happened? They refused to even speak with her, stating flatly that they would have no comment on the man's horrendous behavior. As far as we know, Granados is still employed, but at least he was thrown out of the country club.

It's bad enough that there are few repercussions for the left when they act out, but what is worse is the fact that few individuals in the major news outlets will even bother to condemn bad behavior. It was only after 20 protesters went to Carlson's home while he was at work one day and protested at his front door with bullhorns, terrorizing his wife, who had to hide in a closet to escape them, that some in the media acknowledged this is unacceptable. But that didn't stop others from posting cherrypicked snippets of cellphone videos shot in front of Carlson's home to try and knock down what the Fox News host's wife and daughter had to endure. So much for "#webelievewomen," right?

It's getting to the point that you can't even hold a decent job in some sectors of U.S. industry if you're a conservative. This week, writer Dave Gahary reports on the shocking story of 26-year-old entrepreneur Palmer Luckey, who was fired from his job at Facebook after he was exposed for committing what the left considers to be one of the most egregious sins: Palmer had made a donation

to a conservative group that backed President Donald Trump. Luckey was actually let go back in 2017, but the reason for his termination only recently came out. Apparently, discussions about Luckey's political support for Trump went all the way to the top to Mark Zuckerberg, the billionaire head of the social media company—and, a few months later, Luckey was out the door.

According to a detailed report in *The Wall Street Journal*, Zuckerberg went so far as to ask Luckey to lie and "publicly voice support for Libertarian candidate Gary Johnson, despite Mr. Luckey's years long support of Mr. Trump."

Had any company done this while President Barack Obama was president, the country would have been in an uproar and news of this would have been plastered all over the dailies and the nightly news.

The bottom line here is that the left gets coddled while conservatives are shown the door. And what of freedom and the First Amendment? For all of their talk of diversity and multiculturalism, the truth is, when it comes to what you think and say, the far left isn't interested in any of that. They want one thing, conformity of thought, and the elites are enabling it.

You Gotta Be Kidding: Hillary 4.0

She's back. In a recent issue of The Wall Street Journal, Democratic operatives Mark Penn and Andrew Stein penned an article claiming that Hillary Clinton will be reinventing herself again to run in the 2020 presidential election. "Get ready for Hillary Clinton 4.0," write the two Clinton cronies. "More than 30 years in the making, this new version of Mrs. Clinton, when she runs for president in 2020, will come full circle—back to the universal-healthcare-promoting progressive firebrand of 1994. True to her name, Mrs. Clinton will fight this out until the last dog dies. She won't let a little thing like two stunning defeats stand in the way of her claim to the White House." Even many liberals want Hillary to just go away. Despite Hillary 2.0 losing to Barack Obama in 2008 and Hillary 3.0 losing to Donald Trump in 2016, Penn and Stein apparently believe the fourth time's the charm for the loser candidate. This will be a difficult task, considering her husband's sexual crimes are being discussed in the mainstream. Perhaps that's part of the strategy—to get the story out about Bill's violent sexual assaults well before her presidential run so that Democratic voters can recuperate from and then forget about Bill's crimes.

Instant Justice

Every Democratic senator in a red state who voted against confirming Supreme Court Justice Brett Kavanaugh in October, has lost their reelection bid. They include Democratic Sens. One of the lies the fake news, if you will, media is trying to propagate is the fact that all this weird organic thing and all the water and the food and medicine, all dropped [like] ... manna from heaven. It's bologna. It's all highly organized. It's paid for by a number of organizations; we don't know exactly where the money is coming from."

A History Lesson for Macron

Following his meeting with President Emmanuel Macron, President Donald Trump blasted the French leader after Macron complained about having to pay more for the U.S. to defend Europe under NATO. "Emmanuel Macron suggests building its own army to protect Europe against the U.S., China, and Russia," Trump posted to the social media platform Twitter. "But it was Germany in World Wars One & Two—how did that work out for France? They were starting to learn German in Paris before the U.S. came along. Pay for NATO or not!"

Tax Revenues Hit All-Time High

Washington collected record total tax revenues of \$252 billion in October, the first month of fiscal 2019, according to the Treasury Department. Despite the record high tax collections, the government still ran a deficit of \$100 billion for the month.

A Conflict of Interest

An attorney who was a witness before a grand jury called by special prosecutor Robert Mueller contends that the special counsel's office has a serious conflict of interest. According to the report, Jeannie Rhee, one of the main prosecutors involved in the case, worked for Hillary Clinton and the Clinton Foundation in the past. Ms.



Rhee reportedly questioned witnesses about Republican operative Roger Stone, according to news and commentary website "The Daily Caller." Tyler Nixon, who was an attorney for Stone, said, "[Rhee's involvement] was not disclosed to me prior to my testimony, and I find this to be deeply troubling and certainly Ms. Rhee should be recused or removed from the investigation."



Unhinged Leftists Strike Again

It's not just high-profile legislators and conservative journalists who are being targeted for their political beliefs now. According to *National Review*, journalist Kat Timpf was forced to leave a bar in Brooklyn in early November after a woman she had never met verbally attacked her upon learning she worked in conservative media. "This girl started going nuts on me, screaming at me to get out of the bar. I found her very threatening," Timpf said of the woman. "This is the third time this has happened to me, so I'm just over it," she added. "I'm not on the left or right so I don't really understand this." They're unhinged, Kat, that's why.

More of Judge's Accusers Discredited

• As dust settles, evidence suggests Kavanaugh accusers were politically motivated

n early November, one of Brett Kavanaugh's accusers, Judy Munro-Leighton, admitted to the Senate Judiciary Committee that she had lied about her allegations of being raped by a teen-aged Kavanaugh in the backseat of a car. Ms. Munro-Leighton cavalierly shrugged it off as a "tactic" to stop the judge from being confirmed to the Supreme Court.

Sen. Charles Grassley (R-Iowa) has been in the forefront of those critically evaluating Kavanaugh's slew of accusers. Grassley pointed out Ms. Munro-Leighton's history of leftist activism and claimed that she'd stolen the backseat story from a different "Jane Doe" report.

Grassley's team was able to reach Ms. Munro-Leighton in early November, when she told them she was not this "Jane Doe," but had decided to become involved "as a way to grab attention."

Grassley has also called for the Department of Justice to investigate Kavanaugh accuser Julie Swetnick and her liberal-activist lawyer Michael Avenatti. Grassley charged that they had attempted to "knowingly mislead the committee."

During the Kavanaugh hearings, Ms. Swetnick alleged that Kavanaugh had surreptitiously given women drugs and alcohol in order to orchestrate gang rapes at parties in the early 1980s.

Avenatti's anti-Trump rhetoric was so overthe-top that at one point he offered to fight Donald Trump Jr. for charity. Avenatti, who initially burst into the limelight as the attorney for porn star Stormy Daniels, battled the president constantly on Twitter, calling Trump "a disgrace" and "an embarrassment" and labeling him "a habitual liar."

Ms. Swetnick, in fact, was revealed to have been involved in at least six lawsuits over the last 25 years, according to legal documents seen by press outlets such as "Business Insider." The suits involved multiple issues such as her misrepresenting a degree from Johns Hopkins University that she didn't have, suing the Washington Metro Transit Authority over a fall that she alleged had cost her a lucrative modeling job, and engaging herself in "unwanted sexual innuendo" at a former workplace.

Another Kavanaugh accuser, Deborah Ramirez, claimed that the future judge had exposed himself to her 35 years earlier at a party. She couldn't remember just who exposed himself until Kavanaugh's nomination to the Supreme Court, however, when a conversation with her lawyer, who was a Democratic Party politician, refreshed her memory.

The New Yorker inadvertently did some good

To date, no evidence exists that Judge Kavanaugh has abused women.

work in exposing Ms. Ramirez, whom it described as an "activist Democrat." Ms. Ramirez, even after her belated and dubious identification of Kavanaugh, continued to admit to "significant gaps in her memories of the evening." She also acknowledged being so drunk at the party that she was "on the floor, foggy, and slurring her words."

None of the witnesses named by Ms. Ramirez were able to corroborate her story. *The New York Times*, clearly desirous of damaging Kavanaugh's chances, reported that it had investigated Ms. Ramirez thoroughly but grudgingly conceded she'd been admitting to classmates that she couldn't be certain if it had indeed been Kavanaugh. They eventually were unable to verify her claims.

For what it's worth, Kavanaugh's primary accuser, Christine Blasey Ford, had a slew of problems with her account, which were rarely touched upon by a fawning mainstream media or adoring throng of celebrities. Ms. Ford couldn't recall the exact date of an incident where the

teenage Kavanaugh attempted to remove her clothing. Her description of a party "one summer in the early 1980s" was ludicrously vague and made it impossible for Kavanaugh to establish an alibi. Further, Ms. Ford couldn't recall the specific house or even the street it was located on where the alleged assault occurred. Finally, Ms. Ford didn't tell anyone at the time, not even her best friend.

As was the case with Ms. Ramirez, four different people Ms. Ford claimed had attended the party denied being there. One of them, Leland Ingham Keyser, according to a Sept. 25 story in the *New York Post*, called Ms. Ford "a lifelong fraud." Keyser was one of two people Ms. Ford cited in her original letter to Sen. Dianne Feinstein (D-Calif.), who she claimed she had spoken to immediately after the assault. Even Ms. Ford's parents and two siblings failed to show up during her much-ballyhooed congressional testimony and didn't sign a letter of support from other relatives, which was released to the public.

Ms. Ford, like others involved in the anti-Kavanaugh crusade, was a known Democratic Party supporter, who had marched against Trump. She had also signed a letter protesting the separation of immigrant children from their parents at the border.

On Oct. 6, Kavanaugh was approved by a narrow 50-48 margin in the Senate, reflecting the severe division in the country. ★

Globalists Continue to Undercut Trump's America-First Policies

• Europe, not U.S., to make world "safe for democracy"

s reported in AFP's previous edition, a "Committee to Save the World Order," in the form of a "G-9" geopolitical grouping, has been proposed by two authors who are highly placed in two of the most notorious institutes that have stumped for world government for nearly a century, the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR) and the Chicago Council on Global Affairs (CCGA).

However, CFR Senior Vice President James M. Lindsay and CCGA President Ivo H. Daalder weren't content with their recent piece in the CFR journal *Foreign Affairs*. That article calls for certain foreign militaries to combine forces and take over some aspects of America's "world police" military role, at least until President Donald Trump is no longer president, because Trump is seen as abandoning the "liberal rulesbased world order" built on the ashes of World War II under the tutelage of the CFR, Bilderberg, and related powers behind the thrones of nations.


Fearing the worst, the authors expanded their offensive against Trump's America-first populism with a Nov. 5 *Washington Post* op-ed that

draws on a just-released CCGA survey of Americans and their foreign policy views that builds on the group's 2017 survey of attitudes toward the Trump administration's foreign policy.

The new 40-page report states: "The most common rationale for those respondents endorsing an active U.S. role in world affairs is that the United States cannot avoid international engagement when the world is so interconnected.... Many respondents directly reject an isolationist approach, contending that 'we cannot expect to be isolated and yet a part of the world if we do not actively participate' and 'isolationism is a fool's gambit... Whenever America turns away from the world, the world bites America on the ass.'"

There are some fundamental problems with the survey's approach, however. Professor and director of Notre Dame's International Security Center Michael Desch commented as part of the 2017 survey discussion panel that Trump's policies are more accurately defined as "Jacksonian," or patterned after those of Andrew Jackson—meaning that Trump's foreign policy picks its military, diplomatic, and economic engagements with other nations carefully. That, in turn, would mean Trump is not a literal isolationist to begin with.

As part of CCGA's 2018 panel, Desch again offered some valuable counterpoint, telling Daal-

der and the other panelists: "We live in a world where economic activity is global, and I think even Trump recognizes that. He is not an advocate of autarky [total economic nationalism]. He believes in what he calls fair trade, not trade under multilateral arrangements that he thinks are disadvantageous to the United States. And I think most Americans recognize that."

Desch added that Daalder's belief that, after Trump's presidency, the liberal world order that existed through the Obama years—a "unipolar" arrangement "chaired" by the U.S. since the early 1990s after the "fall" of the Soviet Union—will return to the way it was is unrealistic.


Why? Desch believes American opinion has irrevocably moved away from "some of the pillared positions of the previous internationalist foreign policy" toward a "new world" due to a "tension" between that previous policy and "where I think the public is going today," as Desch summarized, in a rare partial rebuke of the conventional internationalist worldview. ★

Censorship, Gun Control Won't Make Us Safe

• Curbing the First and Second Amendment only helps protect the Deep State

adly, but not unexpectedly, the mass shooting at the Tree of Life Synagogue in Pittsburgh is being used to justify new infringements on liberty. Of course, opponents of gun rights are claiming this shooting proves America needs more gun control. Even some who normally oppose gun control say the government needs to do more to keep guns out of the hands of the "mentally ill." Those making this argument ignore the lack of evidence that background checks, new restrictions on the rights of those alleged to have a mental illness, or any other form of gun control would have prevented the shooter from obtaining a firearm.

Others are using the shooter's history of posting anti-Semitic comments on social media to call for increased efforts by both government and social media websites to suppress "hate speech." The shooter posted anti-Semitic statements on the social media website Gab. Unlike Twitter and Facebook, Gab does not block or ban users for offensive comments.

After the shooting Gab was suspended by its

Internet service provider, and PayPal has closed the site's account. This is an effort to make social media websites responsible for the content and even the actions of their users, turning the sites' operators into thought police.

Some social media sites, particularly Facebook and Twitter, are eager to silence not just bigots but those using their platforms to advocate for liberty. Facebook has recently banned a number of libertarian pages—including Cop Block, a site opposing police misconduct. Twitter has also banned a number of conservatives and libertarians, as well as critics of American foreign policy. Some libertarians say we should not get upset as these are private companies exercising private property rights. However, these companies are working with government and government-funded entities such as the Atlantic Council, a group funded by NATO and the military-industrial complex, to determine who should and should not be banned.

The effort to silence "hate speech" is not just about outlawing racist, sexist, or anti-Semitic speech. The real goal is to discredit, and even criminalize, criticism of the welfare-warfare state by redefining such criticism as "hate." It is not just progressives who wish to use laws outlawing "hate speech" to silence political opponents. Some

neoconservatives want to criminalize criticism of Israel for the nonsensical reason that any criticism of Israel is "anti-Semitic." Other right-wing authoritarians wish to expand hate crime laws to include crimes committed against police officers.

Ironically, neoconservatives and other rightwing authoritarians are among the biggest purveyors of real "hate speech." What could possibly be more hateful than speech advocating perpetual war? Cultural Marxists are also guilty of hate speech with their calls for both government and private violence against political opponents and for the use of government force to redistribute property. Just about the only individuals advocating a political philosophy not based on hate are those libertarians who consistently advance the non-aggression principle.

Preserving the right to free speech is vital to preserving liberty. All who value freedom should fight efforts to outlaw hate speech. Hate speech laws may initially be used to target bigoted and other truly hateful speech, but eventually they will be used to silence all critics of the welfarewarfare state and the authoritarian philosophies that justify omnipotent government.

Italy Leads Pushback Against Invasion

• Interior minister stands up to EU on issue of mass immigration despite threats

point of a political wedge, a populist group of anti-mass immigration, limited-EU intrusion parties and politicians are gaining steam across Europe. The EU is in trouble and appears to be doubling down on the divisive issues that have multiple countries contemplating their own versions of the United Kingdom's Brexit plan at varying levels. The push for Italian independence has been led by Interior Minister Matteo Salvini, who, according to an Italian newspaper poll, is currently the most trusted politician in the country.

Italy's League Party (Lega), which Salvini leads, is currently outperforming coalition partner Five Star Movement (FSM) in the polls, as the FSM has continuously been thwarted by the European Commission in its attempt to implement economic reforms such as the "basic citizen income." Italian citizens have grown weary of succumbing to pressures from the EU's leading globalists.

Mass immigration has Europe's struggling nations bursting at the political seams. In July, Italy refused 66 migrants that a commercial vessel had picked up off the coast of Libya. Salvini had also refused to take back migrants who had left Italy for Germany and had barred any international charity rescue vessels from entering Italian ports.

Salvini stated that Italy had borne more than its share of the burden regarding sea-borne migrants. He told newspaper *Il Messaggero* that Italy's "position is to block in any way possible the trafficking of human beings. We've done more than anyone else. ... That's enough. It's someone else's turn."

The EU leadership has been unsuccessful in trying to convince Europeans that taking in greater numbers of migrants from Africa could be an answer to their own problems of aging and low



birth rates. Salvini has also fought the argument that migrants could fill lower-paying service and agricultural positions that Europeans allegedly refuse to take. Throwing the race card back at the EU, the right-wing Salvini said that the purveyors of that idea are themselves guilty of subtle racism. He then likened the treatment of the migrants throughout the EU to modern-day African slaves. This assertion caused the Luxembourg foreign minister to curse at Salvini in the middle of the migration conference in Vienna.

Last month, Italy began to tangle with the Brussels EU headquarters over their own national budget. Under EU guidelines, it must have Brussels's stamp of approval before its enactment.

As the budget crisis lingers, talk of an "Italeave" has grown. Italeave (the combination of "Italy" and "leave") would be the Italian version of the

UK's Brexit. European Commissioner Jean-Claude Juncker was asked if the EU could survive such an Italeave? "No," Juncker answered. "Europe needs Italy, and Italy needs Europe."

While dissatisfaction is growing in Italy, most EU bloc countries are satisfied with their EU membership, at least in the majority. Strong nationalist movements are quickly growing in both France and Hungary, but in Italy only 44% of the polled population would vote to remain in the EU. That makes Italy the only EU country, at this time, that would vote to leave. Even in Britain, 53% would vote today to remain in the EU. These numbers came on the tail of German news reports that the EU was ready to reject Italy's budget.

The budget crises could cripple Italian markets, yet in the minds of the people, the main issue at hand is still mass immigration. A recent report found that 71% of the Italian people want immigration to be the primary issue atop next year's EU elections.

In an unprecedented move, Brussels has recently given Italian leaders a fiscal ultimatum. Either toe the line regarding EU budgetary rules or Rome will face a 3 billion euro fine. Italian leaders see this as a threat similar to the tactics used by the European Commission against Britain. Then called "Project Fear," EU commissioners first threatened fines and then threatened ruin to any member nation who left the relatively young internationalist cabal of nations.

Italy does currently face its own share of burgeoning crises. Mass migration has caused a displaced population and a bulging of labor and taxation woes. Economically, it also has the second highest debt in the Eurozone. Italy's debt-to-GDP ratio—the difference between borrowing and production—is at 131.8%.

The Italian economy minister has said that succumbing to Brussels's demands and thwarting the option of borrowing would be "economic suicide" for his country.

Italy's economy was suffering before joining the EU, but there is some shared responsibility and then shared success in being able to "think and do" your way out of a crisis. Imagine if America's triumphs were due to Canadian or Brazilian ultimatums and maneuvers. What would be the binding successes of our history?

Italy has a storied past, which textbooks devote entire chapters to analyzing. But will Italy be allowed a storied future—or will Europe's commissioners bureaucratically beat it into submission before it escapes? ★

Pursuit of Regime Change in Iran Will Lead to War

• Neocon warhawks fail to learn lessons of recent past

s Iran deals with recently enacted sanctions from Washington, war hawks in the Trump administration have an eye on regime change, a policy that could lead to a war that would likely have disastrous consequences in and beyond the Middle East.

The neocons include Secretary of State Mike Pompeo, who would be happy to create a famine in Iran, and National Security Adviser John Bolton, who has talked openly about undermining and ultimately overthrowing the Iranian regime. Pompeo has warned Iran that if it wants its people to eat, it should bow to Washington pressure.

Those neocons have in their corner Israel, Saudi Arabia, and its Arab partner in the Yemen war, the United Arab Emirates. In the opposite corner are Russia, China, and most NATO nations, including Turkey. This standoff is having the effect of isolating America from its historical allies in Europe and from the world at large.

The global consensus is that Iran has played

by the rules since it signed the 2015 Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA), better known as the Iran nuclear deal.

President Donald Trump abandoned the deal to please Israel and the Saudis, as well as members of the Benjamin Netanyahu cheerleading group of politicians on both sides of the aisle in Congress. Trump broke from the agreement, knowing there was no evidence to show that Iran was in breach of its promise to discontinue uranium production. His plea to the other signatories to the deal—Britain, China France, Russia, and Germany—to follow his example was rejected. Those nations felt that Iran had abided by its promises to not pursue its nuclear ambitions and ought to be rewarded by not having new sanctions imposed on it.

Trump felt otherwise, yet overestimated his powers of persuasion because his partners not only opposed his actions, but have since been putting in place a mechanism to undermine his sanctions. A financial tool known as a "special purpose vehicle" (SPV) has been created by EU nations to operate in Paris or Berlin with the objective of undercutting the sanctions. The SPV will allow Iranian companies to do business with European companies without going through the



traditional banking system. Instead, they will employ bartering and credits, which Russia will also use. Meanwhile China and India have made it clear they will not abide by U.S. attempts to crush the Iranian economy.


In contrast, Israel has promised Trump that its intelligence agency, Mossad, will help to make the sanctions work, and the Saudis have assured him they will pump more oil to account for the loss of Iranian oil, which cannot be sold on the

international markets. They hope this will stop oil prices rising.

The Israeli and Saudi roles in the sanctions policy appear to confirm their prominent involvement in shaping U.S. foreign policy.

Many experts see the sanctions as the first step in a wider push to force Iran into a conflict, an outcome Netanyahu has been hoping for and the Saudis would embrace as well. Such a conflict by most estimates would quickly engulf the region and beyond. Oil supplies would be halted, creating chaos in the international markets, and American military, political, and economic assets would be at risk in countries like Iraq, Lebanon, and some Arab states.

The reason why some observers worry that the U.S. may be heading for a war with Iran is that Trump, his pro-Israel lobby in Congress, and the Saudis naively believe that sanctions will bring Iran to its knees. When sanctions fail, as they likely shall, neocons like Bolton and Pompeo will come under pressure from Israel and its Washington backers to pursue military options. The American people will likely oppose a war with Iran, knowing our history in recent conflicts and the overarching evidence that this one would be launched to please Israel and Saudi Arabia, unless, of course, some event were to occur that could be blamed on Iran to enflame U.S. public opinion.

Sanctions represent failed policymaking, especially when they are unilateral like these are, unsupported by all the major players to the Iran deal, including the EU, one of the world's largest economic blocks.

For example, as far back as 1997, a report showed that U.S. sanctions were effective only 13% of the time and more often than not cost the American economy hundreds of thousands of jobs and tens of billions of dollars. As Canadian newspaper *The Globe and Mail* put it in May, sanctions have winners and losers.

A war with Iran would be opposed by the international community as well, especially in light of the fact that Iran has stayed true to the nuclear deal. It is already apparent that Trump's decision to abandon the deal was driven by his closeness to Netanyahu and the Saudis.




• Acts of violence against Jews further stifle debate, pave way for more extremism




ver since the killing of 11 worshipers at the Tree of Life synagogue in Pittsburgh, I have been waiting to see how the Israeli government would cynically take advantage of the tragedy to support its own agenda. 

tionately powerful percentage of right-wing American Jews are, however, in love with Trump because of his uncritical support of Israel's actions vis-à-vis its neighbors.

This has meant that some in the Tree of Life congregation have blamed Trump's incendiary language as a contributing element in the hate-filled culture that they perceive as being behind the shooting rampage. Some congregants were opposed to Trump's visiting the synagogue a few days after the incident, but Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and his government quickly intervened to defend Trump against all charges.

Trump encountered protesters as he entered the synagogue, where he was not greeted at the door by one of the rabbis or a congregant. Instead, as he entered, he shook the hand of the Israeli ambassador to the United States, Ron Dermer.

Lara Friedman, president of the Foundation for Middle East Peace, described the bizarre encounter: "The fact that the person who officially greeted the president of the United States at an American city at an American synagogue was the ambassador of another country was stunning."

Dermer had, in fact, been working together with Israeli Minister for Diaspora Affairs Naftali Bennett to counter any criticism of Trump. "I think blaming President Trump for this horrific massacre is unfair; it's flatly wrong," said Bennett before adroitly shifting his comments to

what the president has done for Israel: "The president moved the embassy to Jerusalem. The president is fighting Israel's biggest enemy, which is a terrible regime in Iran. And so, the president is no anti-Semite."

The hypocritical Israeli response to the massacre in Pittsburgh was hardly overflowing with concern for the victims. Bennett took the opportunity to hit out at other targets deemed to be hostile to Israel that could plausibly be linked to the incident, including Nation of Islam leader Louis Farrakhan who had likened Jews to termites. And the Israeli Consul General in New York City Dani Dayan even became involved in the impending midterm elections, slamming Minnesota Democrat Ilhan Omar running for Congress for once having said that Israel is "hypnotizing the world."

Netanyahu also changed the subject from Pittsburgh on the day before the midterms, praising Trump's courage in increasing sanctions on Iran, saying, "I would like to thank President Donald Trump again for a courageous, determined, and important decision. I think that this contributes to stability, security, and peace. . . . This is a great day for the state of Israel. This is a great day for the people of Israel. This is a great day for the future of Israel."

Dermer also implicated Israel's preferred *bête noir*, attacking the role of what he chose to describe as the "radical left." The expression is preferred usage by the Israeli government and its allies in the United States to describe supporters of the Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions movement (BDS). Dermer elaborated: "One of the big forces in college campuses today is anti-Semitism. And those anti-Semites are usually not neo-Nazis, on college campuses. They're coming from the radical left. We have to stand against anti-Semitism whether it comes from the right or whether it comes from the left."

So we can expect the Pittsburgh tragedy to be heavily exploited by Israel and its friends. It will be parlayed into all kinds of mischief on behalf of the Jewish state, with the non-violent BDS movement being particularly targeted. BDS has already been attacked through legislation in 23 states with job applicants or recipients of bene-

fits in some jurisdictions having to sign documents confirming that they do not support any boycott of Israel. There are also a number of federal-level bills seeking to define criticism of Israel as a hate crime with legal penalties attached, a direct attack on the First Amendment. Now that the Democrats are in power in the House, it will get worse, believe it or not.

Five key committee chairmanships will be going to Jewish congressmen, all of whom are ardent Zionists. Two of them will be in key positions to further distort U.S. policy in favor of Israel. Rep. Adam Schiff (D-Calif.) will become head of the House Intelligence Committee and Eliot Engel (D-N.Y.) will be chairman of the House Foreign Relations committee.

Engel is a dream-come-true for Netanyahu, just as Sen. Chuck Schumer (D-N.Y.) is in the Senate. He opposed Obama's nuclear deal with Iran while strongly supporting Bush's decision to invade Iraq and Trump's decision to move the U.S. embassy to Jerusalem. He has attacked the United Nations, the World Court, and the European Union for raising concerns over Israeli violations of international humanitarian law, and he insists that Israel bears no responsibility for thousands of civilian deaths from its bombing of crowded urban areas in Gaza, declaring that Israel is simply exercising its "right to self-defense" and that Israel "goes to extraordinary lengths to target only terrorist actors." He calls

recognizing Palestinian statehood "preposterous," opposes any United Nations involvement in the Israeli-Palestinian peace process, and supports using U.S. vetoes to halt any UN resolutions critical of Israel.

There are far too many Engels in Congress, and far too many in the Trump administration. David Friedman, a former bankruptcy lawyer who is Trump's U.S. ambassador to Israel, recently made a speech in Tel Aviv in which he described the U.S. as his "country of citizenship" while Israel is the country that he "loves so much." Excuse me, but this buffoon is paid a great deal of taxpayer money to represent the United States not to pander to his coreligionists. It is a travesty that he should be an ambassador anywhere and one more example of how none of the rules apply to Israel. Friedman is by his own admission not loyal to the United States. He should be removed from office, and it should be suggested that he turn in his U.S. passport and go to live in the country that he "loves so much." ★







The working class, abandoned by the Democrats, now votes Republican.





• Politically incorrect contenders tap into voter dissatisfaction with establishment

hird party, independent, and write-in political candidates have always faced a major uphill battle in American politics. The two-party system has largely suffocated the growth and development of parties outside of the simplistic Democrat versus Republican, liberal versus conservative political paradigm. This election season was no different. Renegade political candidates did, however, make some noise this past election, garnering major media coverage and exposure on a scale perhaps not seen previously.

Controversial candidates such as Jim Condit Jr., a long-time AFP supporter and contributor, John Fitzgerald, and Arthur Jones, to name only a few, received significant media coverage and made their voices heard in their races using a variety of tactics and strategies.


"My intention with the campaign was to educate people regarding the absolute stranglehold Israel has over our Congress, government, and foreign policy as a whole," Fitzgerald explained.

Jones was the subject of multiple media hit jobs, including a particularly egregious CNN segment that ran earlier this year. Regularly







denounced as a "Nazi" and "Holocaust denier," Jones never backed down and reaffirmed his America-first message throughout the campaign, exposing American voters to political perspectives and opinions many had never heard articulated. Left-wing groups such as the Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC) have long lamented how President Donald Trump's entrance onto the political stage has opened up space for more right-wing political views to gain traction and exposure. The 2018 midterm election was no different in the eyes of the radical left, as "the movement Trump energized will be involved on the national political scene for a while," the SPLC reluctantly conceded.

Renegade candidates, including those highlighted here, have played a key role in helping to open up the political conversation taking place in this country, which was long overdue.

Mueller Subpoenas Trump Associates

• Special prosecutor to question Roger Stone, Jerome Corsi in last-ditch effort to get Trump

r. Jerome Corsi has jumped out of the frying pan and into the fire. The former Washington, D.C. bureau chief for Alex Jones's Infowars website testified once before a grand jury tied to the Robert Mueller investigation on Sept. 7. He is currently submitting to a series of interviews and will appear before the grand jury again. Mueller's investigative team is overtly circling famed Republican operative Roger Stone's closest Trump-era associates, waiting to pounce at any hint of Russian collusion.

The special prosecutor now wants to know if Corsi had any knowledge that Hillary Clinton campaign chairman John Podesta's email had been hacked by Russian agents prior to the 2016 presidential election. Mueller also wants to know if Corsi had any private knowledge that Wiki-Leaks had obtained some of the emails.

It is likely that Mueller already knows the answer to the questions being posed to Corsi. The formality, then, is the offering up of rope so that Corsi, Stone, or another associate can legally hang themselves if they do not answer honestly. New York comedian-activist Randy Credico and the former Manhattan Madam and gubernatorial candidate Kristin M. Davis, both former associates of Stone, have already been interviewed. ABC News is reporting that at least 11 associates of Stone have been contacted by the special prosecutor.



When Jones announced the addition of Corsi to the Infowars staff, he bragged that Corsi and Trump had been acquainted for "40-plus years." Corsi has appeared with Stone on a variety of Infowars programs.

Corsi's attorney, David Gray, has said that Corsi "fully intends to comply with the subpoena." Gray suspects that a majority of the questions presented to Corsi will be designed to delve into the conversations his client had with Stone: Was Stone the pivot between Trump and Wiki-Leaks? When did Stone know that Wiki-Leaks had emails from the Democratic National Convention? And had Stone ever contacted Wiki-Leaks founder Julian Assange?

Stone has been a provocateur in Republican politics since the Watergate era. Driven by a hard edge, a luxurious wardrobe, and killer instinct for the deeper machinations of partisan politics, he has been sought out by presidents and pundits, PR firms and pontificators. After Lee Atwater passed away in 1991, Stone ascended to first chair of the political strategists that politicians need and commentators hate. He is someone who controls the message ahead of the mainstream media, which also makes him the bane of opposition journalists in the field.

It is likely that Mueller will not end this investigation without justifying his appointment via American indictments. As Corsi wrote in his most recent book, *Killing the Deep State: The Fight to Save President Trump*, "If Special Counsel Mueller fails to produce an indictment specifically charging someone in the Trump campaign

with 'Russian collusion,' he will begin to justify Trump's charge that his investigation is a 'witch hunt.'"

If Trump, the whale in this political sea, cannot be indicted, then Mueller seems to be satisfied with the trophies of a few sharks. If Corsi has information useful to Mueller, the special prosecutor's office will soon have it. If so, that may, in turn, help build a case against Stone, Corsi's recent colleague.

At age 72, Corsi may not risk prison time in exchange for party loyalty. In 2007, Corsi had said that he was not even a Republican, blaming the moment of self-realization on the fact that the more moderate "Rockefeller wing" still controlled the party. In 2008, he considered accepting the nomination of the Constitution Party for president but withdrew before the convention.

Stone is also one of D.C.'s coolest characters. If he is worried, it won't show. He will continue to push the narrative he wants believed.



pion, President Donald J. Trump.

The Wall Street Journal broke this story on Nov. 11, in an article entitled "Why Did Facebook Fire a Top Executive? Hint: It Had Something to Do With Trump," which detailed the fate of Palmer Luckey, who, after donating \$10,000 to a pro-Trump group, landed in the crosshairs of Facebook CEO Mark Zuckerberg and literally the rest of SV.

Luckey, 26 years old, with a net worth of almost \$750 million, is "the face of virtual reality in gaming," and has acquired celebrity status with that industry's enthusiasts. Virtual reality is a computergenerated, interactive experience which occurs within a simulated—fake—environment, that "incorporates mainly auditory and visual feedback," with the help of a virtual reality headset. You couldn't tell he's an almost-billionaire, however: Frequently barefoot, even at events, Luckey shares a house with other "gamers."

Luckey stated that reading Trump's The Art of

the Deal when he was 13 years old "sparked his entrepreneurial imagination." A longtime supporter of Trump, he wrote a letter to the future U.S. president in 2011 urging him to run for that office. After Trump won the presidency, "Luckey donated \$100,000 to his inaugural committee."

Because of his private donation, Luckey was put on paid leave and then summarily fired, all in the span of six months.

How deeply someone expressing sentiments counter to the liberal ones that infest SV is loathed was revealed by internal Facebook emails—viewed by the *Journal*—which detail that Luckey's "misstep" "was discussed at the highest levels of the company." Zuckerberg went so far as to pressure "Luckey to publicly voice support for libertarian candidate Gary Johnson, despite Mr. Luckey's years' long support of Mr. Trump."

Consequently, Zuckerberg clearly lied during his Senate testimony earlier this year when he "maintained that politics doesn't play a role in how they police content on their sites," and when he denied

that Luckey's "departure had anything to do with politics." The company he commands also lied in an email to the *Journal*, when it wrote, "We can say unequivocally that Palmer's departure was not due to his political views." Nice touch referring to him by his first name, but it's still a lie.

At a *Journal* tech conference on Nov. 12, Luckey revealed the behind-the-scenes details of how a petition pressured Google this past June to drop out of Project Maven, an artificial intelligence U.S. Defense Department program that would allow the U.S. military to reduce civilian deaths.

"People at Google believed it was a good thing for the country, that it was gonna reduce collateral damage, it was gonna reduce civilian casualties. And then they pulled out from doing the right thing because of protests from . . . a very small vocal minority of their employees. They allowed themselves to be controlled by a pretty radical fringe inside of their own company," he stated.

Luckey then went on to elaborate on perhaps the most insidious reason for the opposition to Google working with the Pentagon.

"It's worth noting that . . . a very large percentage of Google employees are not even U.S. citizens. A large number of those people that signed that petition, saying 'Don't work with the U.S. military,' they weren't U.S. citizens. So, if you have, let's say, a Chinese national living in Europe, working for Google, it's not really surprising that they wouldn't have a strong, positive impression of giving the U.S. military better tools."

It's clear that Google, Facebook, and the rest of SV are not loyal American companies and are in the process of corrupting and overthrowing the values that made this country the envy of the world.

Maybe it's time Trump—who seems to be the only elected representative in all of Washington really looking out for the country's interests—takes a look at Article III, Section 3 of the U.S. Constitution:

Treason against the United States, shall consist only in levying War against them, or in adhering to their Enemies, giving them Aid and Comfort. No Person shall be convicted of Treason unless on the Testimony of two Witnesses to the same overt Act, or on Confession in open Court.

The Congress shall have Power to declare the Punishment of Treason, but no Attainder of Treason shall work Corruption of Blood, or Forfeiture except during the Life of the Person attainted. ★



choice insulting names, and would have 'given hell,' as his nickname historically reminds us," Feinman wrote.

Yet it is Trump's aggression—his boorishness—that some attribute to a personal disdain critics have for him. While Trump can sometimes be petty and can resort to name-calling, it was Truman who threatened violence against a Washington Post music critic who had given daughter Margaret's singing a less-than-favorable review. Truman wrote a letter to the reporter, calling him "a frustrated old man who wishes he could have been successful." Next were the threats.

"Some day I hope to meet you," Truman wrote. "When that happens, you'll need a new nose, a lot of beefsteak for black eyes, and perhaps a supporter below!" Historians chuckle at Truman's brashness as they chide Trump.

Dwight Eisenhower would not have approved

You don't have to be a historian to know that many 20th-century presidents—from Woodrow Wilson to egomaniacal FDRwould have despised the straight-talking, often brash billionaire president, Donald Trump.

of Trump's "abuse of the deferment process to avoid military service" in Vietnam. Eisenhower would have found Trump ignorant, arrogant, cocky, obnoxious, and too willing to lie, according to Feinman. Yet, it was Ike's presidency that historians have termed "the hidden hand presidency," a presidency conducted by an executive largely in private. It was also Eisenhower who in his farewell address would warn against the same "military-industrial complex" that he helped to foster. Under Ike's watch, the CIA grew to be an arrogant agency used covertly to lie about its violent, brash operations, domestic and foreign. The Church Committee of the 1970s saw to it that Americans knew what Eisenhower had supported in secret.

Feinman charges that the incredibly wealthy and blue-blooded John F. Kennedy would have seen Trump as a "spoiled rich kid." Laughably, he asserts that JFK would have been "appalled" that "Trump had a public love life."

Lyndon B. Johnson would have judged Trump as "mediocre ... with no accomplishments worthy of respect." Though Johnson mastered the craft of manipulative arm-twisting and ear-bending, something now called the "Johnson treatment," Feinman says that he would be "alarmed at Trump's affinity for authoritarian leaders."

And then there was Richard Nixon. Surely the man liberal historians still decry as "Tricky Dick" will find reasons to love The Donald. Not at all, Feinman explains. Trump has a nature that even Nixon wouldn't like. The only president to resign the office would be "stunned by Trump's undiplomatic behavior" and "shocked by his basic igno-

rance of world affairs." Regarding comparisons to Watergate, Feinman writes that Nixon would have been "astounded at Trump's ability to 'get away' with so much corruption and would be surprised that the level of corruption is already higher and more substantive so early in his presidency."

Gerald Ford would have been "disturbed that a man with no government experience at all had become president." Should it go without saying that historians are still disturbed today that Ford slid into the White House as a man with no electoral college votes at all?

Jimmy Carter, over time, has developed a record of being outspoken against Trump.

Ronald Reagan, Feinman postulates, would have been "alarmed at the harm Trump has done to the Republican brand." Feinman forgets that Reagan's rise terrified the ruling Rockefeller Republicans that had controlled the party for decades. Reagan was a danger to their brand.

The Bushes, Bill Clinton, and Obama still comment publicly and through active less-than-private leakers. Like Carter, at least they are on the record.

Feinman's conclusion: Trump is unlikable in every way and in every form across the political spectrum of past presidents. But Feinman, himself, has a history. In February 2017, he predicted that Trump would have the second-shortest presidency in history (between the 31 days of William Henry Harrison and the 199 days of James Garfield). In April, Feinman was predicting, again, that the end loomed near for Trump's presidency. "The scandals surrounding President Donald Trump are metastasizing rapidly, much more than

anyone would have thought just a few months ago," Feinman wrote.

At press time, Trump will have been the president of the United States for over one year and 300 days. It was the same media, the media of Feinman, that predicted a Clinton victory in 2016 and then predicted a thunderous "blue wave" in the Midterm elections.

Regardless of what one thinks of Trump, the ex-presidents, as a group, built the national security state that threatens individual rights, they constructed the permanent war state that threatens lives and global stability, and they built the economic infrastructure on which only the rich can thrive and survive. So, there may be a better question: What does Trump think of them?

Allegations of Vote Fraud Ring Out Across America


• Disturbing vote anomalies witnessed in Florida, other states

cross the U.S., there have been reports of voting improprieties and odd occurrences in the midterm elections, including in Florida and in California as well as in Texas, where nine people were arrested for "voter fraud," because they allegedly falsified their identity or engaged in other fraud when they cast ballots.

According to Texas vote-integrity activist Dr. Laura Pressley, founder of True Texas Elections LLC (TTE), official vote watchers who oversaw the midterm elections at the central vote-counting facility in Dallas County found "multiple issues" during the tabulations of early-voting data.

These vote-watchers specified the following irregularities: The presence of wireless and Bluetooth Internet connections in the Central Counting Station where votes are downloaded and tabulated; a voting system computer, seen as having Internet-connection capability, directly

See our big insert in Issue 45/46 mailed last issue! observed communicating over the Internet; and emails were observed being sent from a voting system computer—by a Central Counting Station election officer—meaning email software had been loaded onto that computer.

Dr. Pressley outlined in a news release, "Texas Election Code (129.055) says that the sole purpose of voting system equipment is to conduct an election and only software certified by the Texas secretary of state may be loaded on the equipment. But it is unclear if the secretary of state has certified email software and has authorized installation of such software on computers used at the Central Counting Stations in Texas."

Other problems during early voting included central-counting computer screens being physically covered by election officers, preventing watchers from viewing all the activities. "This is quite concerning, as the Texas Election Code Section 33.056(c) allows an official watcher to view and inspect records prepared by the election officers at the counting location the watcher is serving," the news release added.

While few reports of vote fraud in Texas have made national news, other states were not so lucky.

The multiple recounts and lawsuits in Florida prompted President Donald Trump to chime in, taking to Twitter to express his concerns—especially regarding the seemingly tight race for a key Senate seat between Florida incumbent Bill Nelson (D) and the challenger, GOP Florida Gov. Rick Scott, at a time when every Senate seat counts, as Republicans enjoy a very narrow Senate majority and Democrats re-take the House.

"Rick Scott was up by 50,000+ votes on election day [but] now they 'found' many votes and he is only up 15,000 votes," Trump tweeted on Nov. 9.

Trump then referred to the "Broward Effect," a reference to Broward County, the main location where the vote anomalies have reportedly been happening, even while the vote-count ap-

parently was completed on time throughout the rest of Florida, with the exception of neighboring Palm Beach County.

"How come they never find Republican votes?" Trump added.

Scott filed a lawsuit claiming there's "rampant fraud" in both Broward and Palm Beach counties that heavily favors Democrats, while requesting an investigation by law enforcement as to whether those Democratic-led counties have been purposely conducting extended vote counts well past the Nov. 6 official election day to inflate the Democratic vote.

Recounts are under way in Georgia and California as well, where heated battles are taking place between Democrats and Republicans with each side calling out voting improprieties. ★

steady influx of asylum seekers and ostensible refugees fleeing the Middle East, North Africa, and Central Asia primarily over the course of the past five or more years.

Many view the flood of refugees and other Third World migrants as part of a broader systematic effort to undermine and destroy Western nations by eroding the traditional demographics and displacing the native populations of Europe and other Western nations.

As this newspaper has reported, various NGOs and other activist groups often facilitate the refugee resettlement process and are financially rewarded for resettling Third World migrants in the West. Deceptive tactics are regularly used to facilitate the resettlement process, including forged or faked documents, feigned persecution stories, and other deceitful tactics.

In the video, Ariel Ricker, the executive director of Advocates Abroad, an NGO operating mainly in Greece to provide legal aid to refugees, openly admits to teaching her clients to lie to border agents by pretending to be persecuted Christian refugees or to be in emotional distress. The undercover video will be featured in Ms. Southern's upcoming documentary entitled "Borderless," which focuses on the migrant crisis and massive Third World migration to the West.

According to Ms. Southern's website, Ricker "reveals that her organization has spent time compiling and studying transcripts of asylum interviews" and uses "them to generate stock an-


swers to key interview questions for asylum seekers to use." Advocates Abroad even encourages refugee applicants "to pretend to cry, break down or to ask for a break in order to appear more sympathetic" and gain asylum status.

The release of the video has generated controversy around the world but especially in Greece, which is on the front lines of the migrant crisis as a landing point for countless migrants hoping to gain asylum in other parts of Europe.


Dozens of migrant and refugee advocacy and legal groups operate in the United States. While no officials with these groups have been exposed for coaching illegal immigrants to lie to U.S. authorities, there can be no doubt that this type of behavior goes on regularly all along the U.S. border with Mexico.

Radical Left Shows Its True Colors

• Family of politically incorrect talk show host threatened by unhinged leftists



ucker Carlson, the popular and outspoken Fox News host who continues to dominate the cable news ratings, was recently targeted by antifa protesters at his home in the Washington, D.C. area. Police are investigating the protest, which took place while Carlson was at the Fox News studio preparing for his live nightly news program, as a potential hate crime.

On Nov. 7, several members of Smash Racism DC, a radical left-wing antifa-affiliated group, posted Carlson's home address online before several of its members showed up there to protest. The group of roughly 20 individuals chanted anti-racist slogans outside Carlson's home and called him a "racist scumbag" that needs to flee the city. Carlson's wife was home alone at the time, and she quickly called police after hearing loud banging on her front door and people outside with bullhorns screaming.

"I called my wife," Carlson told *The Washington Post* after learning about the protest at his home via text message. "She had been in the kitchen alone getting ready to go to dinner and she heard pounding on the front door and screaming. Someone started throwing himself against the front door and actually cracked the front door."

The participants in the protest posted a video of their actions on social media, but it was



quickly removed following backlash. In the nowdeleted video, protesters can be heard shouting: "Tucker Carlson, we are outside your home!" Clearly, the group was attempting to intimidate Carlson and his family, a common tactic of radical left-wing antifa groups. Outspoken TV host Tucker Carlson has not been afraid to challenge the twisted narrative coming from the far left and its mouthpieces. For his gutsy stance, Carlson and his family have become a target of violent radicals.

The protesters ludicrously insisted Carlson promotes hate on his nightly news program and preaches "an ideology that has led to thousands of people dying," according to the video. In an obvious attempt at intimidation, one protester can be heard shouting, "We want you to know, we know where you sleep at night!" The group then began chanting, "Tucker Carlson, we will fight! We know where you sleep at night!"

D.C. police quickly responded to the incident, but as AFP goes to press, no arrests have been made despite the horde vandalizing Carlson's home with an anarchy symbol. In the wake of several high-profile arrests of right-wing activists who participated in various political rallies over the past two years, many are wondering when political criminals and terrorists on the left—such as those involved in the attempt to terrorize at Carlson's family—will be prosecuted for their criminal actions.


Alaina Gertz, a spokesperson for the D.C. Metropolitan Police, told the press that an investigation is currently open into the incident.

peaceful manner; however, we prohibit them from breaking the law," Gertz stated the day after the protest. "Last night, a group of protesters broke the law by defacing private property at a Northwest D.C. residence. MPD takes these violations seriously, and we will work to hold those accountable for their unlawful actions."

In Washington, D.C., a criminal targeting someone for their political views can be prosecuted for committing a hate crime.

"It wasn't a protest. It was a threat," Carlson stated in the aftermath of the event. "They weren't protesting anything specific that I had said. They weren't asking me to change anything. They weren't protesting a policy or advocating for legislation. . . . They were threatening me and my family and telling me to leave my own neighborhood in the city that I grew up in."

In related news, it has also been revealed that Carlson's daughter was verbally accosted by an irate man while having dinner with her father and brother at a country club in Charlottesville, Va. last month. Juan Granados, a former member of the country club who has since had his membership revoked for his disgraceful actions, stopped Carlson's daughter while she was walking back to the dinner table after using the restroom. Granados asked the young lady if she was sitting with Tucker Carlson, to which she responded, "That's my dad." Granados then verbally assaulted the young lady, using vulgar language and insulting her.

Carlson and his son then confronted Granados, who became "profane" once again, according to a statement released by Carlson. In response, Carlson's son threw a glass of red wine in Granados's face and demanded he leave the club, which he eventually did.

"Immediately after the incident, I described these events to the management of the Farmington Country Club," Carlson noted following recent press coverage of this incident. "The club spent more than three weeks investigating the incident. Last week, they revoked the man's membership and threw him out of the club."

Holding politically incorrect opinions and being a champion of honest, straightforward journalism is no small task in modern America. As Carlson's experience shows, the radical left will stop at nothing to intimidate and silence their political opponents, often times using some of the most dishonorable, disgraceful tactics available at their disposal.

Macron Blasts Trump as 'Unpatriotic'

• French president preaches globalism, transnationalism, interventionism

n a rebuke bordering on national insult Nov. 11, French President Emmanuel Macron retorted to Donald Trump's calling himself a nationalist. "Patriotism is the exact opposite of nationalism; nationalism is a betrayal of patriotism."

As for Trump's policy of "America first," Macron trashed such atavistic thinking in this new age: "By saying we put ourselves first and the others don't matter, we erase what a nation holds dearest, what gives it life, what makes it great and what is essential: its moral values."

Though he is being hailed as Europe's new anti-Trump leader who will stand up for transnationalism and globalism, Macron reveals his ignorance of America.

Trump's ideas are not ideological but rooted in our country's history.

America was born between the end of the French and Indian War, the Declaration of Independence in 1776 and the ratification of the Constitution in 1788. Both the general who led us in the Revolution and the author of that declaration became president. Both put America first. And both counseled their countrymen to avoid "entangling" or "permanent" alliances with any other nation, as we did for 160 years.

Were George Washington and Thomas Jefferson lacking in patriotism?

When Woodrow Wilson, after being re-elected in 1916 on the slogan "He Kept Us Out of War," took us into World War I, he did so as an "associate," not as an Allied power. U.S. troops fought under U.S. command.

After that war, the Senate rejected an alliance with France. Under Franklin Roosevelt, Congress formally voted for neutrality in any future European war.

The U.S. emerged from World War II as the least bloodied and least damaged nation because we remained out of the war for more than two years after it had begun.

We did not invade France until four years after France was occupied, the British had been thrown off the Continent, and Josef Stalin's Soviet Union had been fighting and dying for three years.

The leaders who kept us out of the two world wars as long as they did—did they not serve our nation well, when America's total losses were just over 500,000 dead, compared with the millions other nations lost?

At the Armistice Day ceremony, Macron declared, "By saying we put ourselves first and the others don't matter, we erase what a nation holds dearest ... its moral values."



Macron is out of touch with current European sentiment, which is leaning toward nationalism.

But Trump did not say that other countries don't matter. He only said we should put our own country first.

What country does Macron put first? Or does the president of France see himself as a citizen of the world with responsibility for all of Europe and all of mankind?

Charles de Gaulle was perhaps the greatest French patriot in the 20th century. Yet he spoke of a Europe of nation-states, built a national nuclear arsenal, ordered NATO out of France in 1966, and, in Montreal in 1967, declared, "Long live a free Quebec"—inciting French Canadians to rise up against "les Anglo-Saxons" and create their own nation.

Was de Gaulle lacking in patriotism?

By declaring American nationalists anti-patriotic, Macron has asserted a claim to the soon-to-be-vacant chair of German Chancellor Angela Merkel.

But is Macron really addressing the realities of

the new Europe and world in which we now live, or is he simply assuming a heroic liberal posture to win the applause of Western corporate and media elites?

The realities: In Britain, Scots are seeking secession, and the English have voted to get out of the European Union. Many Basques and Catalans wish to secede from Spain. Czechs and Slovaks have split the blanket and parted ways.

Anti-EU sentiment is rampant in populist-dominated Italy.

A nationalism their peoples regard as deeply patriotic has triumphed in Poland and Hungary and is making gains even in Germany.

The leaders of the world's three greatest military powers—Trump in the U.S., Vladimir Putin in Russia, and Xi Jinping in China—are all nationalists. Turkish nationalist Recep Tayyip Erdogan rules in Ankara, Hindu nationalist Narendra Modi in India. Jair Bolsonaro, a Trumpian nationalist, is the incoming president of Brazil. Is not Benjamin Netanyahu an Israeli nationalist?

In France, a poll of voters last week showed that Marine Le Pen's renamed party, Rassemblement National, has moved ahead of Macron's party for the May 2019 European Parliament elections.

If there is a valid criticism of Trump's foreign policy, it is not that he has failed to recognize the new realities of the 21st century but that he has not moved expeditiously to dissolve old alliances that put America at risk of war in faraway lands where no vital U.S. interests exist.

Why are we still committed to fight for a South Korea far richer and more populous than a nuclear-armed North? Why are U.S. planes and ships still bumping into Russian planes and ships in the Baltic and Black seas?

Why are we still involved in the half-dozen wars into which Bush II and Barack Obama got us in the Middle East?

Why do we not have the "America first" foreign policy we voted for? ★

Invasion Arguments The Good, the Bad, the Ugly

he 2018 midterm elections should have been about the booming economy. Normally, Americans vote their pocketbook. The truest thing Bill Clinton ever said (maybe the only true thing) was, "It's the economy, stupid!"

Donald Trump's economic boom favored Republicans in the midterms. But both parties focused instead on immigration, and the election was dominated by images of the "migrant caravan" moving relentlessly toward the United States. The caravan, which began in U.S.-military-base-occupied Honduras, quickly swelled to more than 5,000 people. In response, Trump ordered 5,000 troops to the border to repel the "invasion."

Polls show that Trump's economic policies are more popular than his immigration policies and rhetoric, which appeal to slightly less than four-in-10 Americans, while alienating a significantly larger segment of the population. Did the president blunder by focusing so intensely on immigration during the midterm campaign? Was it an attempt to mobilize his base to ensure Republican control of the Senate, while sacrificing less-crucial House seats? Or is the president a man of principle who stands his ground even when it's politically unpopular? If so, that would make him a very unusual politician.

The immigration debate stirs up emotions on both sides, often yielding more heat than light, which makes it irresistible to politicians seeking to mobilize their base. They incite their followers by pushing the usual emotional buttons: Pro-immigration groups call their opponents "racists" and "Nazis" among other unlovely terms, while anti-immigration groups exaggerate the threat


posed by "criminals and terrorists" sneaking into the country.

There are good, bad, and ugly arguments on both sides. Let's start with the good arguments against immigration.

By far the best anti-immigration argument is "population vs. resources." The United States is the world's richest country because a small, ambitious, talented population took over a vast underexploited wilderness rich in resources. Our quality of life, which includes preserving wild nature, will diminish as our population increases and our resources are depleted. Since immigration is by far the biggest contributor to population increase, slowing or better yet stopping immigration is crucial to preserving our quality of life. The notion that we need endless growth, driven by an ever-growing labor force, is rank nonsense spewed by ignorant economists brainwashed into loving today's cancerous usurybased economy.

Another good argument against immigration is that it drives down wages for unskilled American workers. This is undoubtedly true. The counterargument, "No Americans will do these jobs," is absurd, because supply and demand would quickly raise wages to whatever level it takes to convince the native worker that the job is worth doing. So yes, well-off Americans would pay more for their vegetables if farm workers were paid \$20 an hour; but poor unskilled Americans would be vastly better off due to all those \$20-anhour jobs—which are now being filled by impoverished immigrants willing to do them for a whole lot less.

A somewhat less-compelling argument holds that immigration threatens America's cultural cohesiveness. Historically, poor immigrants from various parts of the world have been coming to the United States and gradually assimilating. It is



possible that something has changed that makes today's immigrants less prone to assimilation, but I have not found compelling evidence to support this assertion. On the contrary, it seems that cultural degradation, in the form of the breakdown of family values, is an internal American phenomenon. If anything, immigrants seem to have stronger family values than natives do.

Along with the good and so-so arguments against immigration, there are the truly ugly ones. The notions of "Hispanic criminality" and "Islamic terrorism" are obscene nonsense spewed by xenophobes and the crooked politicians who exploit them. Statistics compiled by conservative publisher Ron Unz among others show that Hispanic immigrants are less prone to criminal behavior than native-born Americans. And the whole bogus "Islamic terror" threat was manufactured by neocon Zionists using 9/11 and other false flags. American Muslims are actually better law-abiding citizens, with stronger family values and lower crime and violence rates, than native-born non-Muslims.

As for pro-immigration arguments, they cannot successfully refute two key points: (1) Quality of life depends on population vs. resources, and (2) unskilled American workers are hurt by immigration. The honest pro-immigration arguments are: "To hell with working-class native-born Americans, I want my cheap fruits and vegetables!" "To hell with the environment and real quality of life, I want a bigger GDP!" "I like having people around with whom I can practice my Spanish!" "I like having more people coming to our local mosque!"

I personally agree with the latter two propositions. But viewed objectively, I am not sure they are terribly compelling arguments. ★

A Different Opinion . . .


In light of all the negative statements about undocumented immigrants—including refugees from Central America—usually supported by AFP articles, I should like to submit the statements below. Perhaps they may give cause to and promote a better feeling of humanity toward people dismissed too easily. At least the statements may be food for thought.

My points are:

As a young nation, the United States is populated mainly by descendants of immigrants many of whom arrived from outside countries without anyone's "permission." Our rather immediate ancestors simply came to these shores without "legal status" demanded by any governmental entity.

When any human being occupies peacefully and productively any spot where he lives for five, 10, 20 years, he has very possibly earned an intrinsic right to live unmolested by others.

As an oligarchic society, the United States government rarely reflects in its rule the opinions, feelings, or beliefs of the majority of its citizens. Animosity toward the undocumented is not a majority opinion.



The current U.S. immigration laws are not written to make immigration easy for most anyone. Byzantine rules are applied arbitrarily by government agents who do not apply them fairly. In most cases there are no "legal" remedies for an undocumented resident, nor can he return to his country of origin to apply for admission.

The vast majority of undocumented residents are heavily associated by birth, marriage, friendship, and consanguinity to United States citizens who have no ability to assist them in attaining legal status. Therefore, deportation of these people would result in misery and unparalleled difficulties for native-born citizen.

The discrimination toward Mexican and Central American peoples of color refuses to recognize that these people are Amerindians who have until recent times moved within the Americas without the interference of more recent European immigrants.

The European migration to America resulted in the enslavement and destruction

of the native inhabitants without respecting the rights of these people to live on their ancestral lands.

The vast majority of undocumented people perform highly important work disdained by citizens, to wit: the harvest of crops. Remove them and we will not have enough food supplies at prices we now enjoy.

It is morally reprehensible to uproot families, destroy homes, and drastically change lives of others unless they are guilty of felonious behavior.

Who's the Real Bigot?




Now then, let's stop affording them any more ammunition by referring to them as liberals. It's a term which only gives them more power.
